Tampa, FL - Local members of TrueMajorityACTION have volunteered to drive George around the Bay area as Tampa's participation in the national tour, "Liar, Liar, Pants on Fire." The 12-foot high statue of George Bush, riding atop a flatbed trailer with his derrière on fire, is fanning the flames of activism across the United States. A political rally, 8 pm Monday, February 9 at 2904 N. Tampa Street, kicks off Tampa's weeklong leg of this event.

Norwood Orrick, one of the local organizers, says the rally will give people a chance to enjoy an evening of good, political fun. "Turn off the TV and be a REAL part of the democratic political process," says Orrick. "Come out and get a free flag, a hotdog and some ice cream, and enjoy an evening out with people publicly expressing their views and learning from each other!"

The flatbed trailer supporting the GWB statue is set to arrive at the rally at 9 pm sharp. It's pulled by a Ford Crown Victoria with Diplomatic-style American flags waving from the fenders. The "flames" flapping from George's backside are actually ingeniously lit up streamers that give the illusion of fire. But there's no illusion for fired up

TrueMajorityACTION, founded by Ben Cohen of Ben and Jerry's Ice Cream fame, intends to encourage more people to get involved in progressive politics by targeting "cultural creatives" with events like, "Liar, Liar Pants On Fire." Tampa's TrueMajority members plan to fan the flames with their message: "George has lied and his record is terrible. People need to know this, and they need to feel that they are not alone when they get fired up about learning the truth."
